

**NOTICE OF GENERAL ELECTION
BERTIE COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA**

A General election will be held in Bertie County on Tuesday, November 4, 2014 to vote on Federal, State, District, and County Offices; Nonpartisan Judicial Offices; Nonpartisan Board of Education; Nonpartisan Soil and Water Conservation District Supervisors; a NC Constitutional Amendment, and County Sales Tax Referendum. The polls will be open for voting on that day from 6:30 a.m. to 7:30 p.m. at each of the 12 polling places. The polling places are located at:

All residents of Bertie County who are registered to vote with the Bertie County Board of Elections may vote in this election. Any person who is already registered to vote need not re-register to vote for this election. Those residents of the county who are not registered to vote must register before Friday, October 10, 2014 at 5:00 p.m. **Persons who are not registered to vote in a county can no longer register to vote in person during the one-stop early voting period. Same day registration is no longer an option.** Any voter who has moved outside his or her precinct but within the county since the last election should notify the board of elections in writing by October 10, 2014.

Absentee ballots are allowed and requests for an absentee ballot must be made on the State Absentee Ballot Request Form and received in the Bertie County Board of Elections office by 5:00 PM on Tuesday – October 28, 2014. Hand-written requests will no longer be accepted. Absentee voting by mail begins Friday, September 5 and ends Tuesday, November 4 at 5:00 p.m. The board of elections will meet on October 14, October 21, October 28, and November 3 at 5:00 PM; on November 14 at 10:00 AM; and at other times as may be necessary for the purpose of approving absentee ballot applications.
